ISGQ-2003-00072355 The following 31 page file dated 20011008 includes lists of volunteers and hand written letters from inmates in the Adults Rehabilitation Center in Baghdad to the President. In the letters they expressed their adherence to the leadership and voiced a dogged persistence to act as [Human Bombs] against the U.S and its ally Israel. Responding to Saddam's speech in which he urged the Iraqis to sacrifice their lives for the Palestinian brethren, the 3-20 year sentenced prisoners called on the President to include their names on the martyr's lists and vowed to liberate the occupied Jerusalem. Relevant correspondences are also included in this document.
