13. Assignment to a group of the Fedayeen for a special mission from the president
14. mission were carried out as noted in our letter number 1239 dated 13 Aug. 1995
 - a. 520 deserter from military, thieves, and smugglers are in custody
 - b. confiscated 315 copper pieces and thirteen tons copper ready for smuggling
 - c. confiscated 21 vehicles loaded with gasoline prepared for smuggling
 - d. confiscated 24 pieces of weapon with ammunition in their position and military equipment in their position
