all especially the Chemical, the is a point maybe Lt.General Husayn will explain its details, because they did explained to me, and I understood it. They have brought new information it was not there before, and it is that Iraq bought or contracted or talked about the subject of some kind of Parachutes that are used with Missiles. What is this Parachute? Why do you link it to the Missile? Does it mean? Then you...

Male 2 You want to make it a Germ?

Male 3 Yes, the intention is that the Missile will be filled with Chemical or Germ, and when it comes down it will cover a wider circle than the traditional Missile.

Male 2 That's good they are teaching us things that will be useful in the future.

Male 3 It's a fact that our people have talked about this kind, but not in intention and they explained it to them, just like Mr. Foreign Minister said, and our guys are, it does exist the subject of searching for a Parachute and the Missile will discharge from it before it hit the ground, and they wanted to attach a camera on the Missile to record, and the camera will explodes with the Missile, they want before the Missile comes down, the camera will come with the Parachute so they can find the parachute's location, not the Enemy, to record the whole event of what's happening to the Missile. So the last they said, weight the Parachute, because the Missile has weight, and the small camera has weight too, so if the Parachute carries a very heavy weight, then your theory will have..So it's getting finalized Sir, this what you call it that belong to the Irrigation Ministry, Scales and [Unintelligible] they have it, we in the 70's and 80's Mr. President you know yourself and the

expert comrades in all fields. Iran, and here are the Security Council resolutions, which were written by your ambassador in New York and we agreed to them, why don't you want to give us weapons? She said No and this is our decision.

I told her that "but you are giving weapons to the Iranians", She said No, we are giving them none lethal weapons.

I said what you mean none lethal, you are giving them the Engine for the Senterium Tank, of course the Engine doesn't kill, but when you put the Engine on the Tank and the Tank has Shells then it is killing us, I told him this discussion took place, I went to Hazeltein he was the Defense Minister I discussed the issue with him to tell you the truth Hazeltein was softer than Margaret Thatcher, and he said "we will follow up the issue don't be hopeless".

They didn't give me, I told the Soviet Defense Minister and he told me "We don't have this kind of Missiles, we have Nuclear Missiles, Conventional Warheads we don't have" I said to him "Take away the nuclear head and replace it with Conventional Head and I will pay for that".

You remember your Honor's

Instructions. I told him he didn't accept, so the Russians whom were allies of Iraq didn't give us Missiles, you think London will give us? What kind of logic is this? He said Brazil we don't mind and Egypt, I said Egypt..

Male 3 It's a joke, they solve it Sir, it was solved during the visit, the Chemicals purchase orders of 1988,89,90 there was left one point that was solved too, there is nothing essential left about the Missiles and Chemical, and he did admit in the second meeting he said there issues...

The problem is the Biology, the biology in my expectation and I don't want to hurry now, I think in my estimation that we will solve it, we can find a solution, but in this issue we have to have help from the Russians and the French, I requested from Lt.General 'Amir and Riyadh to get involved on this issue.

they can't do anything.

Male 3 On this Biological issue, the French
and the Russians if they help us/ we
can find a solution, I don't think its
difficult, and the talk about Iraq is
producing and they will use it for
terrorism, this is nonsense talk,
everybody can say that.

Male 2 Terrorism is coming to them,
Americans before 2000 long time and I
think the British too, it exist I think
Hamid was recording with one of
them, I told him in the future terrorism
will be with weapons of mass
destructions, so what's going to
prevent? Technology will advance and
this is long time ago I mean on 1989,
we shouldn't be surprise to see to see a
car bomb with nuclear explodes just
like Washington, either Germ or
Chemical.

Biological, biology is so simple in it's
composition, any biologist can make a
bottle filled with Germs and throw it in
water tank, and kill 100.000 person, so
this is not a country, you can't accuse a
country, one person can do it. One
American person can do it in a house,
next to the White House; there is no
real logic in it except if there is a large
establishment, like Al-Hakam, in fact
Al-Hakam is exposed for destruction,
because if they can convince the others
too that this establishment with what it

has of equipments, it doesn't have
Machines does it Abu 'Ali?

Male 4 No, No, it has reactors.

Male 3 Yes, just walls and windows, so for
fact they will demand to destroy it,
then our position will be strong,
because the others will say get rid of

Male 4 Sir in Al-Hakam they measured
everything, all Air-conditioning, and
its soil, and the surrounded area, and its
labs, and it ended on 1992 Biology
ended.

becoming a story, and then when they
finished their job

Male 3 Ekeus did admit to the Russian
ambassador that the Americans opened
the Biological issue.

Male 2 Yes, Dr. Ahmad.

Male 5 Sir President the Leader, I was the
director of Al-Hakam, means General
Director of Al-Hakam, I met them in
Four Rounds, some of the rounds were
all day, what displease them is first: the
distance of the location, and we
answered that the area is truly an
industrial area and it has projects for
the Military Industrializations and it
has paved streets and electricity and
water.

And the Second thing is: we have a
project in the same area its called PC2,
this one is originally for a Mono
Protein it prepares the Primary
Substance for Al-Hakam Project,
which is Methanol, its supplied by the
project next to the building across the
street, very close.

Sir, one of the questions they asked
was, of course their meeting with the
individuals was one at a time,
beginning from Dr. Ruhab ending with
the youngest person and they are a very

small number of people, they are not a lot like 100's, very small number. They ask many questions including the following question: How come you guys authorized so much money to this kind of place? I asked him what are the amounts? Whatever you see is administrating building and roofs, and all you saw are bricks and cements and those materials are available in our country, and this is completed industrial area, and it has this and many other projects starting from Fallujah in Saddam's Establishment and Al-Shahid Factory in the other side, and in the other side there is also other projects in the same area. I told him "what details did you see in those ceilings proves of producing Biology, the doors are not secure, not even the structures are for Biological research"?

Male 2 The Palace that the Americans are talking about and are disturbed from it is next to it, if you have Biological would you build a Palace? Talk to them this way. Tell them this Palace that the Americans are calling Saddam Hussein's, this is next to the Biological, if somebody has such a project, why would he build a Palace? Why, the Iraqi is anti germs? Only French and Americans die with Germs?

Male 5 Sir, they started their work, as you know with the Al-Salman Site, and they inspected every inch of the Site, and they used two methods walking, checking the soil, and everything, and the Second method was Helicopters communicating from helicopters with the ground and they were spread all over. And they inspected every square meter in the Al-Salman, I remember one day during the argument somebody

came happy carrying something...

Male 2 And also Al-Salman, if it has Biology how could you put Biology next to the Nuclear Reactors, and kill our own Atomic Scientists?

Male 5 Sir, they saw all this, we even have a presidential building it is not bigger than 500 meters or 400 meters, the building exists and you Sir sometimes you stop by it and you see it.

Male 2 The one that belongs to the Intelligence.

Male 5 Yes Sir

Male 2 Guest House, Yes.

Male 5 Sir, once we were sitting, and one of them came with him a wing for an Unmanned Aerial Vehicle, I don't know where he found that in garbage or whatever, and the argument on that started.

Male 2 And they said this is the mother of the Biology.

Male 5 First, we told them look at its size, the payload was maybe 3 or 3.5 Kg, do you think that this is the great work that we are inventing methods to carry Biological with a Plane, Yes we do have UAV project and the story ends. Sir, on some buildings they asked us where did we throw the waste? We had them away some distance in fact they sent a working group, even in the waste they were looking; they wanted to prove what they could prove that we produced Biological Weapons. I remember at one meeting he had a map and two pictures, one of the Buildings truly was destroyed, and Al-Salman they bombed 14 times, the first day and the last day and in between 12 times, and in every time a plane comes, we have a Building with few floors they didn't leave it alone until they brought it to the ground. So they brought the Two Pictures, and the building itself is not bigger than

half of this table, there was nothing left of it was destroyed, and we told them yes we took the debris away and it was a small building, also they asked where is the Waste of it, they went to the garbage and searched it, and they brought shuffles and they dig about Two meters down in the foundations maybe they will find something has Germs or Biological, they didn't find nothing.

Sir we do have a Site next to Al-Hakam, the area is Projects area many Projects, at that time we wanted to Import Three Fermenters, of course Sir the Fermenters that we have are no good, and they know its Technical Specifications won't produce Biological weapons. And Biological Weapons need temperature with specific pressures, and doors windows etc.. very secured, and very précised specifications, not any site can produce Biological Weapons, we had a Site we wanted to have a Contract with a Swiss Company, the company said we have to see the Site that you want to construct on, they came and saw it, then we didn't have Al-Hakam yet, they came and saw it finally they didn't give us the Fermenters, until the Mother of All Battles happened we didn't get the Fermenters.
